

Senator Rockefeller Announces WV Homeland Security Summit Being Planned for March 19 & 20 at Stonewall Jackson Resort

In November, 2003, the WV Summit on Homeland Security brought first responders, law enforcement, and health, industry, education and public policy leaders to Shepherdstown. We began a dialogue about making our State and this great nation safer.

I don't need to tell you that we still face challenges from domestic and international terrorism, as well as from natural disasters. That is why I am working with Governor Manchin and the Discover the Real West Virginia Foundation (DRWV) to hold another Summit, early next year, to continue the dialogue.

The 2006 West Virginia Summit on Homeland Security will be held at Stonewall Jackson Resort on March 19 and 20, 2006.
